**FOCUS** wishes to confirm that nothing said here necessarily reflects the views of any individual Liberal Democrat councillor about the merits of any particular planning application.

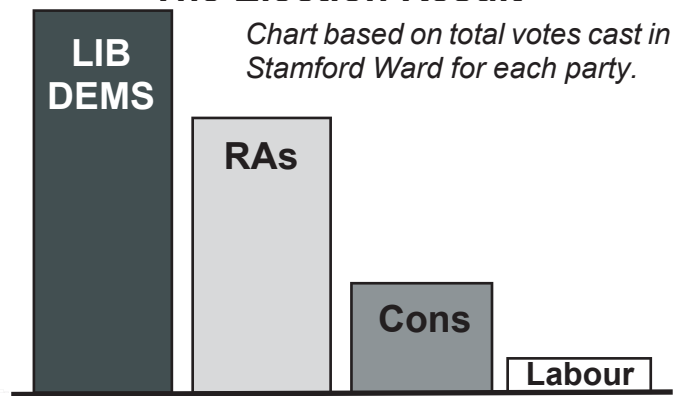
## Wells House

Chart based on total votes cast in Stamford Ward for each party.



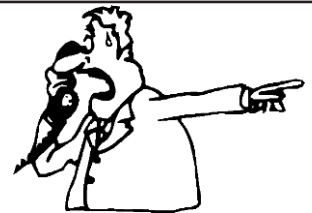
